Organ Repair Update

Just before Easter, our organ's mechanical problems progressed to the point where we could no longer rely on it. That is the reason why we have not been using the organ for the last few months. We have talked with a handful of pipe organ companies and have received formal proposals from two highly-regarded firms. In order to repair the organ, it will cost approximately \$120,000.
