Pentecost Sunday

Today, Christians across the world are celebrating Pentecost. Pentecost is not as well-known or as popular as Christmas and Easter, though it commemorates a watershed event in Christian history. In many ways, Pentecost is the birthday of the church. For Christians, Pentecost is a holiday for celebrating and remembering the coming of the Holy

Spirit after Jesus' death, resurrection, and ascension. Set fifty days after the celebration of Easter, the name comes from the Greek, pentekoste hemera. The events of Pentecost are recorded in the second chapter of The Book of Acts. It is in remembrance of these events that we celebrate Pentecost today. The liturgical color is red. This is one of the very few times the color red is used in the liturgical year and it recalls the tongues of fire that day.
